






#### SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

- After having removed the appliance from its packaging, verify its integrity based on the drawing and check for any damage caused during transport. If in doubt, do not use the appliance and contact the authorised service centre.
- Do not let children play with the packaging! Keep the plastic wrapping out of the reach of children; risk of suffocation!
- Before connecting the appliance, check that the mains voltage data reported on the technical data corresponds to that of the available electric mains. The technical data is attached to the label of the appliance.
- This appliance must only be used as a heated throw for domestic use as indicated in the instructions. Any other use is to be considered hazardous.
- This appliance can be used by children aged from 8 years and above and persons with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities or lack of experience and knowledge if they have been given supervision or instruction concerning use of the appliance in a safe way and understand the hazards involved. Children shall not

play with the appliance. Cleaning and user maintenance shall not be made by children without supervision.

• The appliance is not to be used by people who are insensitive to

heat or vulnerable and unable to react to overheating.

 This appliance must not be used by children aged from 3 years and above if the control devices have not been set beforehand by a parent or guardian or if the child has not been properly instructed on how to use the device safely.

WARNING – NOT suitable for children under the age of 3.
 Children under the age of 3 must not use the appliance as

they are unable to react in the event of overheating.

• O DO NOT activate the temperature control with wet hands.

• O DO NOT pull the power cable or the appliance itself to remove the plug from the socket.

 Always disconnect the appliance from the mains supply before cleaning or performing maintenance and when the appliance is not in use.

 If the appliance is faulty or malfunctions, switch it off and do not tamper with it. Any repairs must only be carried out by an authorised technical service centre.

• If the power cable is damaged it must be replaced by an authorised technical service centre, so as to prevent all risks.

• The appliance must be used solely with the types of control indicated on the label.

• O DO NOT place the control unit under the pillow or between the sheets or bed covers when the appliance is connected.

 Inspect the appliance frequently to check for signs of wear and tear. If such signs are found or if the appliance has been used incorrectly, contact an authorised technical assistance centre before continuing to use it.

- O DO NOT use on an adjustable bed. If the appliance is used on an adjustable bed, check that the throw and cord do not become trapped or rucked, for example in hinges.
- O DO NOT tuck in.
- This appliance is not intended for medical use in hospitals.
- O DO NOT use if wet.
- **○** DO NOT use the appliance to keep animals warm.
- O NOT INSERT PINS OR NEEDLES.

#### POSITIONING THE THROW (DIAGRAM A)

Sit on your sofa and place your throw over you for blissful comfort.

 You may wish to wrap the throw around you but do not wrap tightly or sit on the throw as this may cause the overheat protection system to activate. Do not allow the throw to ruck or crease.

**POSITIONING AND FITTING INSTRUCTIONS** 

#### FITTING INSTRUCTION

Join the connector (2) of the control unit to the connector (1) on the blanket. Ensure the connector is pushed home until the locking catch engages (**Diagram B**).

#### USING YOUR THROW

To operate the throw, insert the plug into the mains power supply and switch on the socket. If the lead does not reach your socket, you can increase the cable length by adding a BSI or ASTA approved extension cable, available from all good electical retailers.



WARNING! Only use the electric throw with the control unit supplied. The control model is specified on the care label sewn on the throw. Never cover the control unit with the electric throw.

· Connect the plug into the mains socket.

#### SWITCH ON/OFF

- ON To switch the electric throw on, switch to ON position (I) on the back of the control (7) (**Diagram C**), and select your required temperature.
- OFF To switch off the electric throw, switch to OFF position (O) (7) (Diagram C), on the back of the control.
- Switch on the throw, from the back of the control, by positioning the switch ON (I) (7) (Diagram C).
- When the controller is turned ON, set to setting 6 (FAST PREHEAT) (red light).
- To operate, just select your preferred temperature setting from 1-5 by simply pushing the temperature button (5) (Diagram C) until the temperature setting desired will light up on the temperature display (3) with an orange glow. If left at this setting for longer than 8 minutes, the controller will default to this setting when next switched on.

#### **AUTO OFF FUNCTION**

- The throw is fitted with an AUTOMATIC SHUT OFF system of 3 hours. When the timer period time has elapsed, the throw will switch off and the indicator (6) will turn blue.
- To turn the throw on again, switch the on/off indicator switch (7) (Diagram C) to off then on again.

#### DISCONNECT

• To disconnect your throw from the mains, switch the control to OFF position (O) (7), and then safely disconnect the plug from the mains socket.

#### **USE DETACHABLE CONTROL SWITCH**

The throw has a detachable control which allows the electric throw to be washed. The throw may be disconnected from the control switch by separating (1) and (2) (See Diagram B). Press retaining clips at the side of the connector with thumb and forefinger and remove control unit with your other hand.





#### **CLEANING AND MAINTENANCE**

#### WASHING INSTRUCTIONS

The Dreamland throw is suitable for washing.

40	Wash at 40°C.	0	Tumble dry at a temperature that is less than 40°C

#### WASHING

- Prior to washing disconnect the control lead from the throw, as in Diagram[B].
- Before washing the throw it is essential that you measure it, to ensure that it is stretched to approximately its original size during the drying process.

## MACHINE WASH

• The throw may be washed in a washing machine at 40°C on a wool programme.

## HAND WASH

- Use a mild washing powder or detergent and luke warm water to soak your throw for 15 minutes. After soaking, gently wash the throw and rinse thoroughly with clean, lukewarm water.
- Allow the excess water to drain from the throw. It may also be gently squeezed, but never wring the throw.

## X NEVER DRY CLEAN

• Spin dry on wool programme only. O **DO NOT** use an extra spin cycle.

## DRYING

- Tumble dry on low settings.
- Air dry on a clothes line, but do not use clothes pegs on the wired area of the throw as they may damage it.
- O DO NOT use your throw until it is completely dry.

#### STRETCHING

- The throw must be stretched back to approximately its original size during the drying process.
  This is best done whilst damp, working from side to side, stretching a strip at a time. This procedure may need to be repeated a few times until fully dry.
- Inspect the throw to ensure that none of the wires have formed into loops, or become twisted back on themselves. Holding the throw up to the light will make it easier to inspect the wires.
- If any problems with the wires persist after the stretching process, or the throw does not return to close to its original size, return it along with the control to our Service Centre for a safety inspection.

### **STORAGE**

#### When not in use store as follows:

ATTENTION! When storing the appliance allow it to cool down before folding.

ATTENTION! Avoid creasing the appliance.

ATTENTION! ○ DO NOT place heavy items on the throw when in storage, as deep creases or folds may damage the wiring.



ATTENTION ! ODO NOT use any moth proofing chemicals.

#### TROUBLE SHOOTING

These appliances are built to the very highest of standards. There are no user serviceable parts. Follow the solutions if the unit fails to operate. You can also refer to the trouble shooting on our website www.dreamlanduk.co.uk

Problem	Solution

The light fails to illuminate on the control	- Check fuse has not blown

	Check the throw connection is pushed fully home		
The time out indicator light on the control is flashing blue when switched on	Throw or control is faulty. If the throw is damaged, discontinue use and return it to our Service Centre for a safety inspection.		
The supply cord or any wiring is damaged	The appliance must be returned to the Service Centre for replacement to prevent a hazard. On NOT attempt to repair it yourself.

#### AFTER SALE ASSISTANCE

#### REGULAR SERVICING

The appliance must be repaired at the manufacturer's Service Centre, the defective appliance, if under guarantee, must be sent to the Service Centre for replacement repairs with a proper receipt or invoice that attests the date of sale of purchase.

Your throw should be returned for a safety inspection at least once every 2 years. It should be suitably packed with control, lead and original fitted plug.

To ensure minimum inconvenience, please return your throw for routine safety inspection between April and September.
