This foaming spray effectively cleans carbon residues, burnt on wood sap, soot and other debris off the glass of wood-burning stoves without scrubbing.

Directions for use:

- Pinch together the red tabs under the trigger and pull down towards the neck of the bottle. The trigger is now ready to be used.
- As the trigger is pulled for the first time the protective seal over the nozzle will snap off.
- Simply spray on, leave for a few seconds and then wipe off. For stubborn residues, apply another layer and leave for a few minutes before removing.
- Once you have finished using the Stove Glass Cleaner push the red tabs upwards until they lock into place and prevent the trigger from being pulled. The bottle is now ready to be stored.

DO NOT USE on hot surfaces, marble and other chalky natural stone, aluminium and plastic surfaces. Avoid the liquid running on to other surfaces and protect the surrounding area if necessary. Always test on an inconspicuous area first and use in a well ventilated area.

Contains: <5% anionic and non-ionic surfactants. Sodium hydroxide.



Danger
