Marc de Champagne centre coated in icing sugar.**

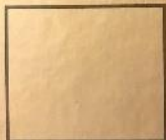
Ingredients: White chocolate (51%) (sugar, cocoa butter, whole MILK powder, emulsifier (SOYA lecithin), natural vanilla flavouring), milk chocolate (27%) (sugar, cocoa butter, whole MILK powder, cocoa mass, emulsifier (SOYA lecithin), natural vanilla flavouring), salted butter (MILK) (11.5%), icing sugar, Marc de Champagne (2.5%), white rum, colour (beetroot red), natural flavouring (strawberry).

Milk chocolate contains cocoa solids 33.5% minimum and milk solids 20.5% minimum.

Store in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight.
