

Can be used on interior surfaces around the home, especially in the bathroom and kitchen. Works on tiled surfaces, silicone seals, grout and around windows.

#### **DIRECTIONS FOR USE:**

From approximately 5cm distance spray the affected area, leave the formula to work for 30 minutes, clean the treated area with a cloth and water, repeat for stubborn stains.

Always test on an inconspicuous area before use. Use in a well ventilated area. Not suitable for chrome, stainless steel, aluminium, enamel, marble, wood and granite.
