

Whiten old or discoloured grout whilst resisting mould and mildew.

Directions for use:

- Remove any loose grout.
- Clean grout using a non acid based cleaner, rinse with clean water and allow grout to dry overnight.
- Leave cap on and shake tube.
- Remove cap and apply an even coat of the Tile Grout Whitener by positioning the sponge applicator in line with the grout and squeeze the tube whilst running it down or across the grout line.
- Leave for 3-4 hours or until firmly set and wipe off the excess left on the tiles with a damp cloth. Tile Grout Whitener remaining on the tiles can be removed by dampening and leaving for 5 minutes before being wiped off.
- A second coat can be applied if required.
- To finish wipe down and polish with a dry cloth.
- Shower for 12-24 hours before having a bath or shower.
- Before storing the Tile Grout Whitener remove the applicator sponge and wash thoroughly with water.
- Attach cleaned applicator sponge and tighten cap.

Coverage: Up to 8m² of coverage when used on grout surrounding 15cm sq tiles.

Care: Store in a cool dry place and ensure cap is on tight. Only suitable for glazed ceramic tiles. Do not use on porous tiles or tiles with a metallic finish. Not suitable for nonporous grouting containing epoxy, silicone or concrete.

Keep out of reach of children. Do not get in eyes, on skin, or on clothing.

IF ON SKIN: Wash with plenty of soap and water.

IF IN EYES: Rinse cautiously with water for several minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present and easy to do. Continue rinsing.
