

## CARING FOR YOUR KITCHEN TROLLEY

Thank you for purchasing an Eddingtons' trolley. Made by skilled craftsmen from solid beech this elegant but durable item of kitchen furniture will last for many years to come. No other type of surface offers the timeless beauty and warmth that a solid wood worktop can bring.

Every Eddingtons trolley is constructed from the finest materials and before leaving the factory undergoes a quality inspection with each worktop receiving a final application of oil by hand before dispatch.

With proper care and attention your trolley will age gracefully and provide you with years of service and pleasure. In order to preserve the appearance of your trolley please adhere to the care instructions below:

### **Location:**

Do not position your trolley near a radiator or open fire or expose it to direct sunlight or other heat sources. Equally do not store or use the trolley in damp or cold rooms. Your trolley should be kept dry.

### **Oiling:**

Oil your trolley with the oil provided using a soft clean lint free cloth. Please apply the oil in line with the recommended frequency below.

***Once a day for a week, then once a week for a month, and once a month thereafter.***

After oiling please do not use the trolley for at least 20 minutes. Remove any surplus oil with a dry cloth. Do not oil the lacquered parts (end grain designs) of the trolley as they are treated with wax and do not require any additional oiling. Do not oil the metallic parts of the trolley.

### **Preserving the life of your work surface:**

In order to prevent surface damage to your kitchen trolley we would strongly recommend the use of an additional kitchen board for chopping and cutting. After use clean the trolley with a moist cloth then wipe dry with a soft cloth or clean paper towel. ***Do not unduly wet the surface of the trolley.*** Do not wash any parts of the trolley in a dishwasher .

**Painted Trolleys** - We recommend wiping painted surfaces with a clean damp cloth then drying thoroughly. Painted surfaces do not require oiling.

### **Locking the wheels:**

Should the trolley be fitted with wheels we advise locking them once the trolley is in position. Each pair of wheels is equipped with a small lever which prevents movement when applied. Simply push the lever down by foot to lock the wheels. To release simply push the lever upwards. Be careful when moving the trolley. There should be no free standing or unstable objects on the work surface which could damage the trolley or injure others.

Wood is a natural material and this gives each piece individual characteristics. Our skilled craftsmen seek to combine the different features of grain, shade and texture to enhance the appearance resulting in each trolley being totally unique.
